

# What should you do if you smell gas?

In the event of a gas escape:

## Don't

---

**Don't** smoke.

**Don't** use naked flames.

**Don't** turn electric switches on or off.

**Don't** leave it to someone else.

## Do

---

**Do** turn your gas supply off at the emergency control valve (usually next to your gas meter).

**Do** extinguish all naked flames and sources of ignition.

**Do** open doors and windows to allow gas to disperse.

### **Additional information for LPG bottle gas users**

**Do** turn your gas supply off at the emergency control valve or cylinder valve or both.

If possible move suspected leaking cylinders into a well ventilated safe area, away from sources of ignition.
